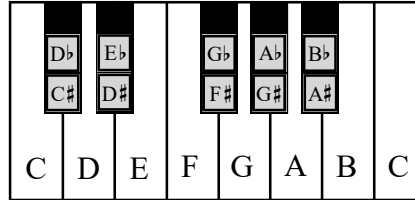


# Enharmonic Notes I

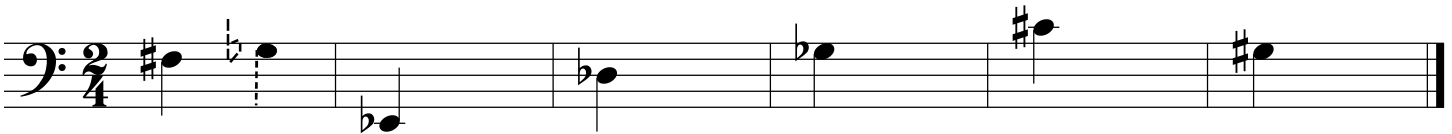
In music there are many notes that have more than one name.

If you look at a piano keyboard you will see that D $\sharp$  and E $\flat$  are played with the same key.

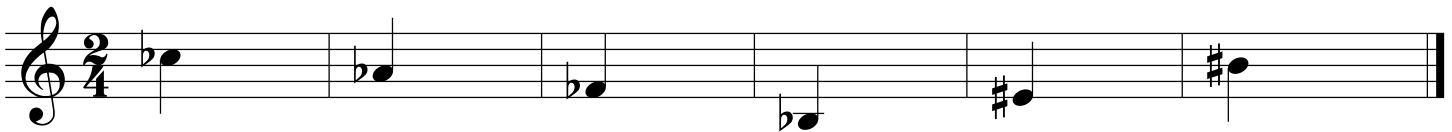

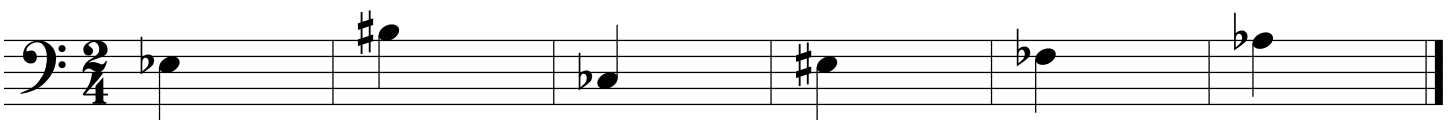
